Electronic 50/50 Rules of Play

1. The lottery will take place at the Wheels on Danforth street festival at 3345 Danforth Avenue on:

- Saturday, August 18, 2018

2. The following individuals are not eligible to participate in 50/50 draws:

- **Employees of Variety- the Children's Charity of Ontario and Variety Village**
- **Volunteer ticket sellers**
- **Intoxicated persons**
- **Persons under the age of 18**

3. Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle systems supplied by Canadian Bank Note Company Limited, an approved vendor of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).

At a cost of: **3 for \$5, 10 for \$10 or 60 for \$20**

4. After purchase, sellers will give the purchaser a receipt with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be assigned.

5. The winning number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw for that day/game.

6. The estimated prize amount of the 50/50 will be shown on two roving backpack screens throughout the festival and on the 50/50 sellers' hand held devices.

7. The winning number will be announced at the end of the awards portion of the festival.

8. How to Claim a Prize;

On-site winners can report to the main stage at the festival within 30 minutes of the draw announcement or; if the winner is no longer in attendance, they may claim their prize by contacting: Zoë Pagazani at 416-699-7167 ext 290, or by email at: zpagazani@varietyontario.ca. The winner must present their winning ticket at Variety Village, 3701 Danforth Avenue, Scarborough Ontario M1N 2G2 for verification at a mutually agreed upon date and time.

9. Winners must have the original winning ticket- copies will not be accepted. **All payments will be made by cheque within 30 days of claiming a prize** in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that game. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.

10. The winning number will be announced on stage at the Wheels on the Danforth festival and on the Variety Twitter feed @varietyvillage.

11. The winning ticket holder has **six months** in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchased on, after which the prize will be donated to a charity other than
